Guests are welcome at **11:00am**.

Exhibitors are required to sell family-friendly items and services that align with the Academy's mission. A panel of judges will visit each table to judge exhibitors in one or more of the following categories:

Category 1: Table Displays

Vendor tables will be provided by the Holiday Inn. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring promotional materials, eye-catching table clothes, banners, signs, posters, balloons, and/or other decorations. Videos, slide shows, computer simulations, demos, digital designs, animations, and other media that incorporate visuals and/or audio are also encouraged. Electrical outlets will be available for laptops and other chargeable electronics.

Category 2: Business Idea

Exhibitors are invited to sell a variety of business products and services (Including, customized T-shirts, tote bags, caps, jewelry, baked goods, dolls, books, homemade soap, artwork, crafts, bookmarks, lemonade, beaded bracelets, decorative candles, greeting cards, games, toys, etc.). Participants will be judged on their ability to clearly and confidently discuss their business idea, target customers (Men, women, kids, teens, family, church members, others), potential competitors (Other businesses that sell similar products and services), and how their business can help the community and others.

Category 3: Artistic Talents
